Many things are taken into account when judging each model including Workmanship, Level of Finish, Parts Manufactured, Level of detail and Origin of the Design. Please supply any additional information that will help in the judging of your entry. If you intend to supply more detailed judges notes and pictures then please bring these to the exhibition with your model.

General Conditions of Entry

- Entries will only be accepted on official Exhibitor Entry Forms and strictly one entry per form (a photocopy of this form is acceptable).
- All models must remain on display until the exhibition has closed.
- Any exhibitor wishing to 'steam' their model must have permission from the Exhibition Organisers, a valid authorised test certificate for the relevant pressure vessel and appropriate insurance of public liability.
- The use of any flammable substances is strictly controlled and may only be carried out after seeking permission from the Exhibition Organisers.
- Display Cards (provided upon registration at the exhibition) must be clearly displayed at all times.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to display "Model for Sale" signs or any other commercial material.

Additional Competition Rules

1. Models that have achieved a 1st, 2nd or 3rd Certificate in previous years may not be re-entered into competition unless substantial alterations have been made.
2. Models that have achieved either Commended or Highly Commended in previous years may be re-entered if significant re-working has taken place.
3. Unfinished models may not be entered into competition. They can however be entered into Display and entered into Competition following completion.
4. The decision of the Chief Judge and Exhibition Manager is final and binding.
5. Models entered into competition must be the work of the person or persons entering the model into competition.
6. Any work carried out by a third party must be declared on the entry form.
7. Any commercially bought parts must be declared on the entry form.
8. Entry into competition by professional model makers is not permitted.
9. It is not possible to guarantee the return of model photographs.
